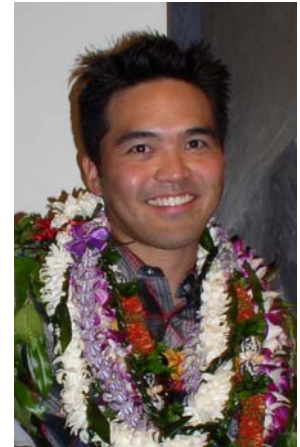

### **Criteria for entering contest:**

- 1) Completed hand drawn work not to exceed 8-1/2" x 11".  
(No frames please)
- 2) All mediums are allowed – pencil, colored pencil, pen, etc.
- 3) All entries should depict a "Matsuri" (Japanese festival) theme.  
Matsuri theme items can include chochin (lanterns), decorations, etc.
- 4) Each entry must have official entry form, along with disclaimer form (parental signatures are required), taped to the back of the artwork to be accepted.
- 5) Entrants must specify *Manga* Style or Traditional Art category.
- 6) Entries will be accepted at the *Manga & Art Exhibit* at the Maui Matsuri festival between 2 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.\*  
**\*Entries may also be submitted during the week of May 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> at John Henry Photography, Inc.'s photo studio at 59A Kanoa Street in Wailuku (located in the former Hokama's Music & Color TV building and next to the Wailuku Treats & Sweets). Studio hours of operation are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**
- 7) Judging will begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. at the festival. Winners will be announced at the exhibit area at 5:00 pm.
- 8) Artwork should be picked up at exhibit area by 6:00 pm, otherwise include a self addressed stamped envelope for return of artwork.
- 9) Submissions will be judged in four age divisions for both *Manga* style and Traditional Art categories: Kindergarten – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup> grade – 8<sup>th</sup> grade and 9<sup>th</sup> grade – 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

The top three (3) winning contestants from each category and age division will be awarded cash and/or Omochaya gift certificates . Contest sponsored in part by Omochaya.
